The Batemans Bay Marina will serve as a gateway for people to visit, enjoy and learn from the stunning marine environment protected in the Batemans Bay marine park. The location of the marina in close vicinity to the marine park represents both a responsibility and opportunity for the marina.

The Batemans Bay Marina will:

- have a responsibility to implement best practice environmental management and continued environmental improvement in Marina operations to protect the fragile ecosystems of the marine park
- improve access to the marine park, allowing a greater variety of people to enjoy and learn from the unique marine environment
- provide a valuable opportunity for greater study of and learning from the marine park and the ecosystems contained within it, through the possible location of a marine research and interpretive learning facility within the marina.



Environmental Impact Assessment

Ariadne is working with a team of specialist consultants to undertake a comprehensive environmental impact assessment to inform the detailed design and finalise the project application.

Some of the issues under investigation include:

- hazard management and mitigation
- water cycle management
- heritage and archaeology
- flora and fauna
- noise
- air quality
- aquaculture
- navigation and safety
- social and economic impact

The results of the environmental impact studies will be documented in an Environment Assessment report and will be submitted to the NSW Department of Planning to support the project application.
